Tools

- ❖ 6 Popsicle Sticks
- ❖ Thick String
- ❖ Silver Foil
- ❖ Glue
- ❖ Silver Paint
- ❖ Paintbrushes
- ❖ Blue and White Tissue Paper
- ❖ Silver Washi Tape (Optional)
- ❖ Blue and White Pony Beads



Step 1:

Take 6 popsicle sticks and paint them silver. Allow them to dry completely.

If you don't want to paint, you can use silver washi tape to cover the popsicle sticks. You will need to glue on the washi tape to make sure it stays. Allow it to dry completely.



Step 2:

Make a triangle shape with 3 popsicle sticks. Glue the triangle together.

Using 3 more popsicle sticks, make another triangle shape and lay it on top of the first triangle. Adjust until it looks like the Star of David.

Glue the second triangle shape together and onto the first triangle.

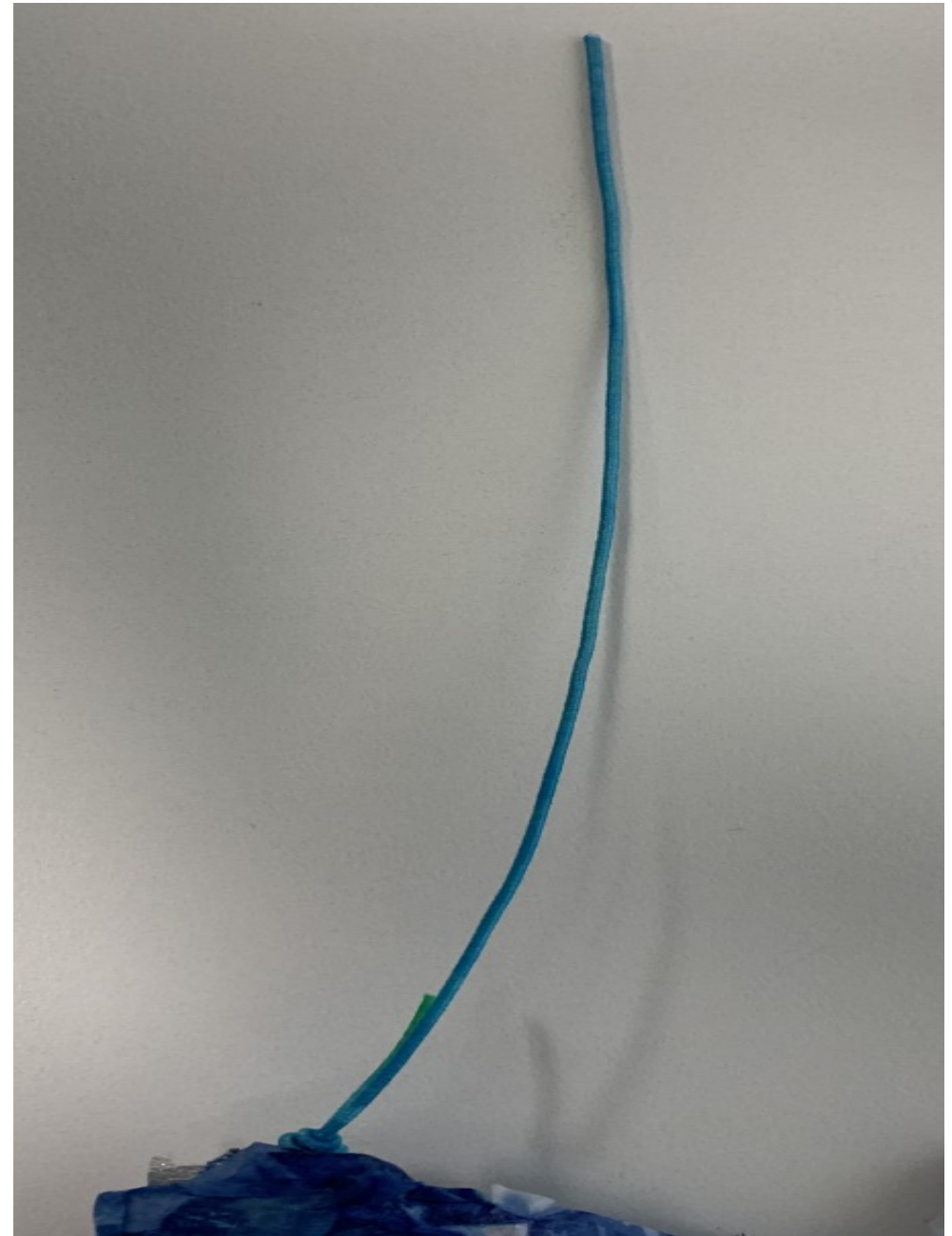


Step 3:

Put down a piece of silver foil as your workspace.

Flip your silver Star of David over so you see the wood of the popsicle sticks, not the silver where you painted.

Take a piece of string and tie it to the top part of the star. Let it hang until later.



Step 4:

Make a paste from $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of water and $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of glue. Mix it together well until it's combined.

Cut up small pieces of blue and white tissue paper. Using a paintbrush, paint some of the paste onto pieces of tissue paper and cover the back of the Star of David.

You want to cover the entire wood side, covering all the holes. Use the paste to help “glue” down the tissue paper.



Step 5:

Allow the Star of David to totally dry with the tissue paper facing up.

Once it's totally dry, trim off any extra tissue paper that got on the sides so it's neater.

Using the beads, bead the string that's attached to the top of the star. Tie the two strings together to create a loop so the star can be hung up somewhere the sun will reflect.
