- Model Magic White or All Colors (or Play-Doh)
- **❖**White Glue
- Craft Supplies (Pom Poms, Googly Eyes, Pipe Cleaners)
- Cupcake Sheet With Liners
- Paint (Optional)
- Paintbrushes (Optional)









CUPCAKE MODEL MAGIC

- 1. This can be made with Play-Doh if you don't have Model Magic.
- 2. If you have colorful clay, you can use that. Otherwise, use white clay and you can paint it after it dries in 48 hours.
- 3. Make sure to leave your cupcake creation in the cupcake pan for 48 hours so it can dry in the shape of a cupcake.
- 4. Once it's fully dry, you can paint it, but then allow it to dry for another 24 hours before moving.

Step 1:

Line a cupcake tray with liners so the clay doesn't't stick to the tray itself.

Roll out a piece of the clay into a big ball. Smoosh it into the cupcake try. Make sure it fits inside really well, and it's touching the sides of the cupcake liner so when it dries, it gets the lines of the cupcake line.



Step 2:

Take another piece of clay and roll out long into the shape of a snake.

Wrap the snake around the ball of clay you smooshed into the cupcake liner. It should be twisted around each other so it looks like a swirl of frosting.

Make sure to pinch it tight at the top so the clay sticks to itself as it dries.





Step 3:

If you used white clay and want to paint your cupcake, then put the cupcake tray somewhere safe to dry. It needs to dry for 48 hours so it's hard and fully dry and you won't ruin the shape when you paint it.

Once it's dry, take your cupcake out and paint. If you want to add glitter for sprinkles, gently add some on to the wet paint. Allow the cupcake to now dry for another 24 hours before moving it.

ALIEN MODEL MAGIC

- 1. This can be made with Play-Doh if you don't have Model Magic.
- 2. If you have colorful clay, you can use that. Otherwise, use white clay and you can paint it after it dries in 48 hours.
- 3. Make sure to leave your alien creation on a sturdy plate for 48 hours so it can dry in the shape of your alien.
- 4. Once it's fully dry, you can paint it, but then allow it to dry for another 24 hours before moving.

Step 1:

Roll out a piece of clay into a big ball. Smoosh and shape it into your alien's body.

It can be big, small, colorful, have 18 arms...it's your alien!

Take smaller pieces of clay and make your alien a mouth, eyes and ears (if your alien, has those, of course!)





Step 2:

If you used white clay and want to paint your alien, then add on the antennas first.

Cut a pipe cleaner in half and stick it into his body, for antennas. You can glue two pom-poms to the pipe cleaners for the tips of the antennas.

Put your plate somewhere safe to dry. It needs to dry for 48 hours so it's hard and fully dry and you won't ruin the shape when you paint it.

Once it's dry, paint your alien. Glue on some googly eyes and shapes until your alien is perfect. Allow the alien to dry for another 24 hours before moving it.



Step 2:

If you used colorful clay and aren't going to paint, let's finish your alien creation! With a little bit of glue, add on some googly eyes.

Cut a pipe cleaner in half and stick it into his body, for antennas. You can glue two pom-poms to the pipe cleaners for the tips of the antennas.

Add other shapes and googly eyes and things to your alien until you're happy with how he looks.
