



SALT ART MILKSHAKES

Tools

- ❖ White Table Salt
- ❖ White Glue
- ❖ Colorful Sand (optional)
- ❖ Food Coloring
- ❖ Shaving Cream
- ❖ Red Pom-Poms
- ❖ Sprinkles or Glitter
- ❖ Plastic Bowl
- ❖ Plastic Straw
- ❖ Sundae or Regular Cup



Step 1:

If you have colorful sand at home, you can begin the project and skip this step. If you don't, we are going to make some!

Measure out 1 cup of salt and pour it into a bowl. Repeat as many times until you have bowls for all the colors you want to make.

Add 10-12 drops of food coloring to each bowl and add more if you want a darker color.

Mix until the salt is fully colored and has no clumps in it.



Step 2:

Once you have all of your salt “sand” colored, let’s start to build your milkshake.

Layer the cup with the colored salt in whatever pattern you want (or make it all one color) until it’s almost at the top of the cup.

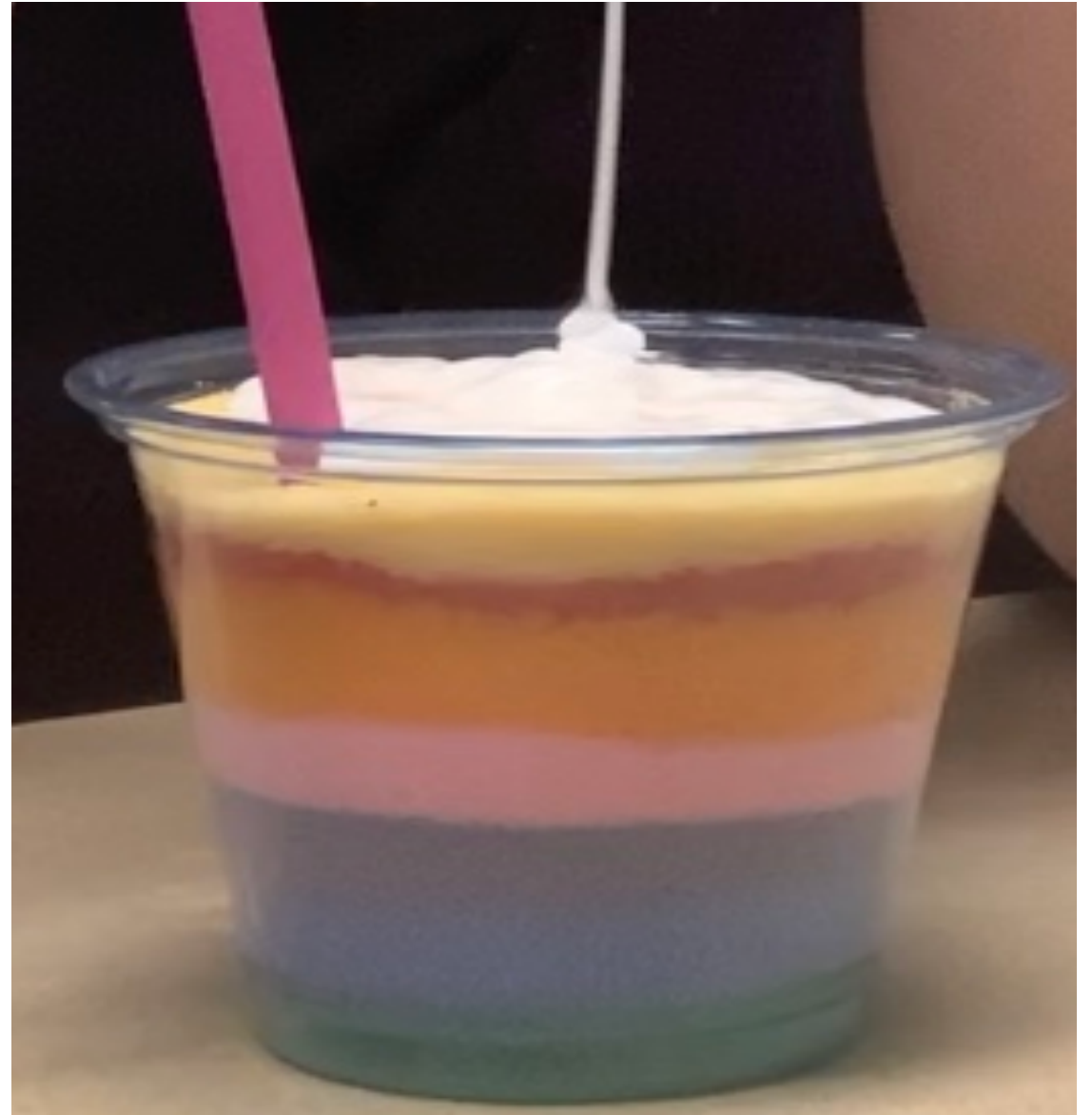
Make sure to leave a little room at the top for the whip cream!



Step 3:

Pour a thin layer of glue on top of the sand art. Make sure it covers all of the sand art so when it dries, it seals the sand into the cup.

Mix 1 cup of white glue and 1 cup of foaming shaving cream together. Once it's fluffy, scoop or pipe it onto the glue so it looks like whipped cream.



Step 4:

Gently put the red pom-pom onto the whipped cream and press it in slightly so it sticks.

Sprinkle on some glitter or sprinkles onto the whip cream if you want some.

Carefully push a straw through the whipped cream and into the sand art.

Allow the milkshake to dry for 24 hours before moving it.
