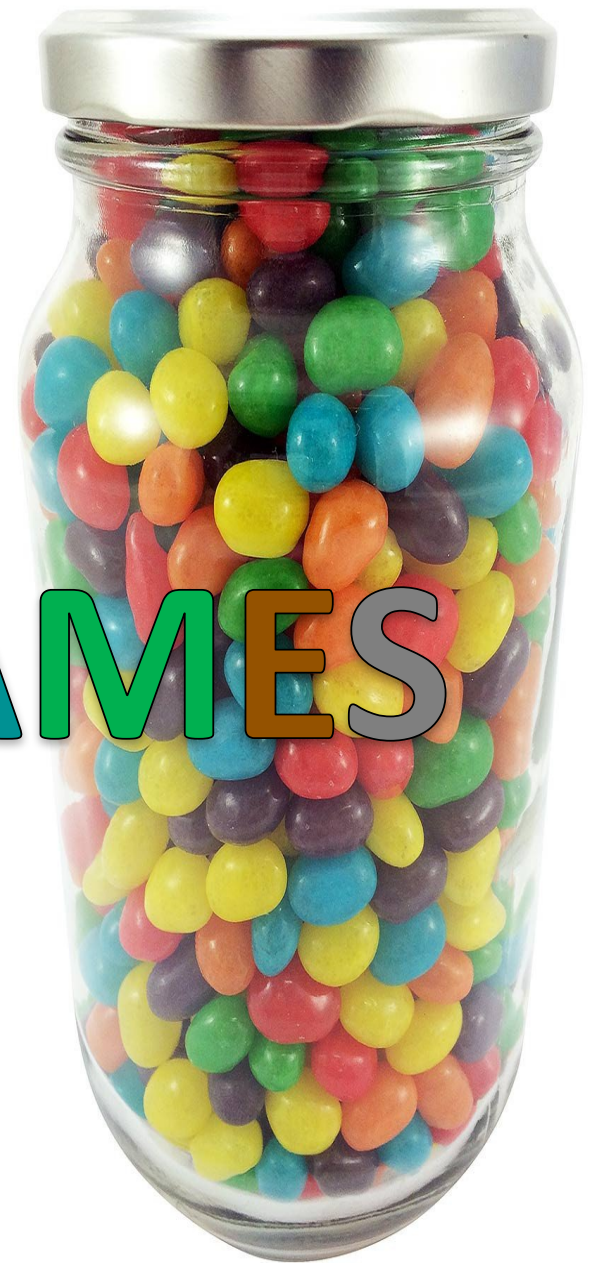

# Knock Down Tools

❖ 10 Plastic Cups

❖ Squishy Ball



# Knock Down:

Stack the ten cups in a pyramid shape, with four cups on the bottom, then balancing three cups on top of that, balancing two cups on top of that, and carefully placing the last cup on top.

Let everyone take a shot (or two!) with a soft ball and try to knock down all the cups in in one hit.

See how good your aim is by backing up a little every time and throwing from farther back each time!





# Guessing Jar Tools

❖ Jelly Beans, Beads, or Any Small

Candies or Items

❖ Plastic or Glass Clear Jar





# Guessing Jar:

Whatever item you choose (I used beads), make sure to count it out before you put it into your jar so when people guess, you know how many are really in there.

Write down all of the guesses in a notebook with the person's name who guessed next to their guess so when everyone is done guessing, you can announce the winner!



# Pong Toss Tools

❖ Hard Board or Box

❖ 10 Plastic Cups

❖ Glue (Hot Glue)

❖ Squishy Ball

❖ Markers

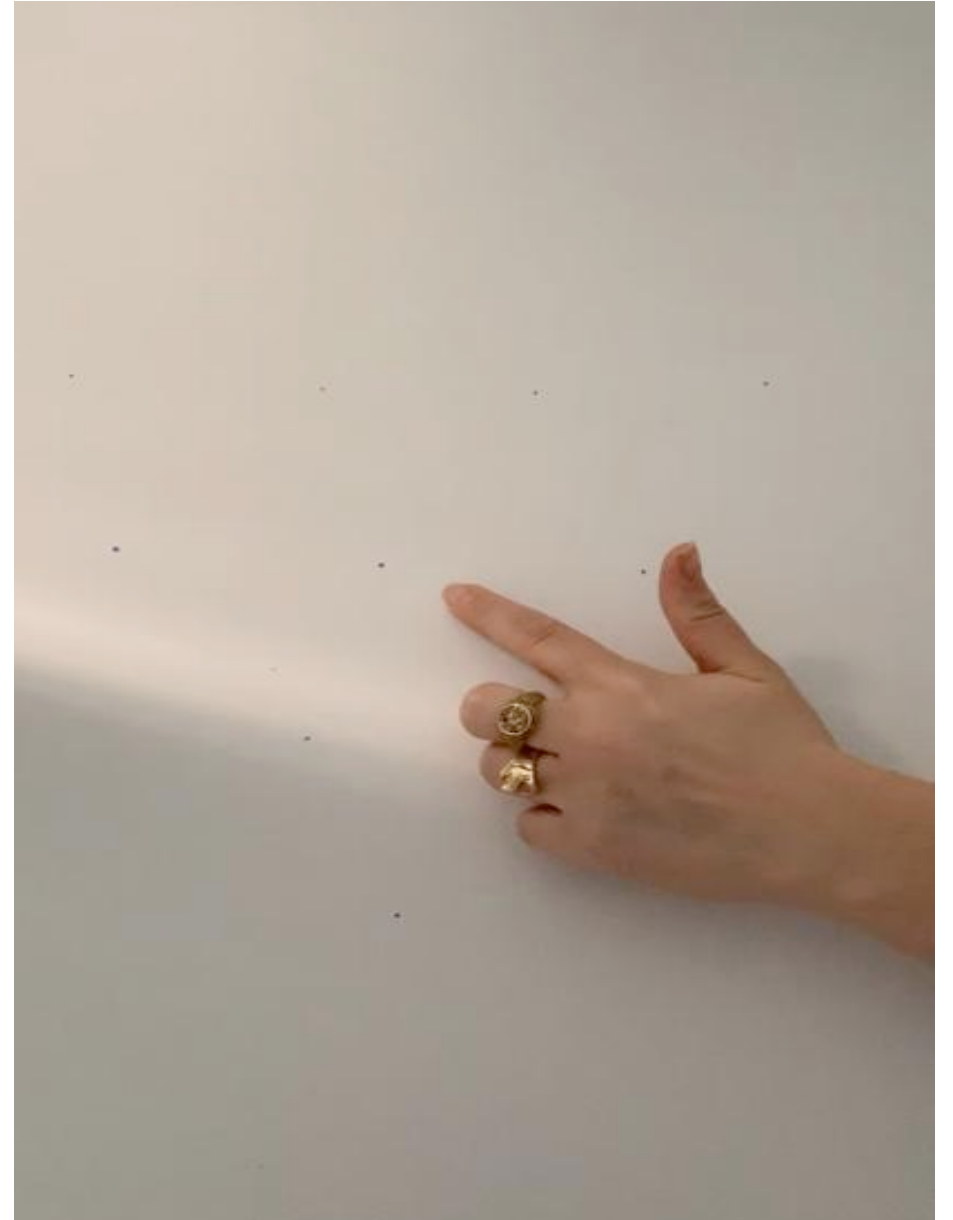


# Pong Toss Step 1:

Get your board ready to be turned into a Pong Toss Game!

If you are using a cardboard box that's brown, you can glue on white or colorful construction paper to make it a different color.

Take the cups and line them in a pyramid on the board. Mark where the cups are so you have an easier time gluing the cups down. This will also help you know where you shouldn't decorate because the cups are being glued there.



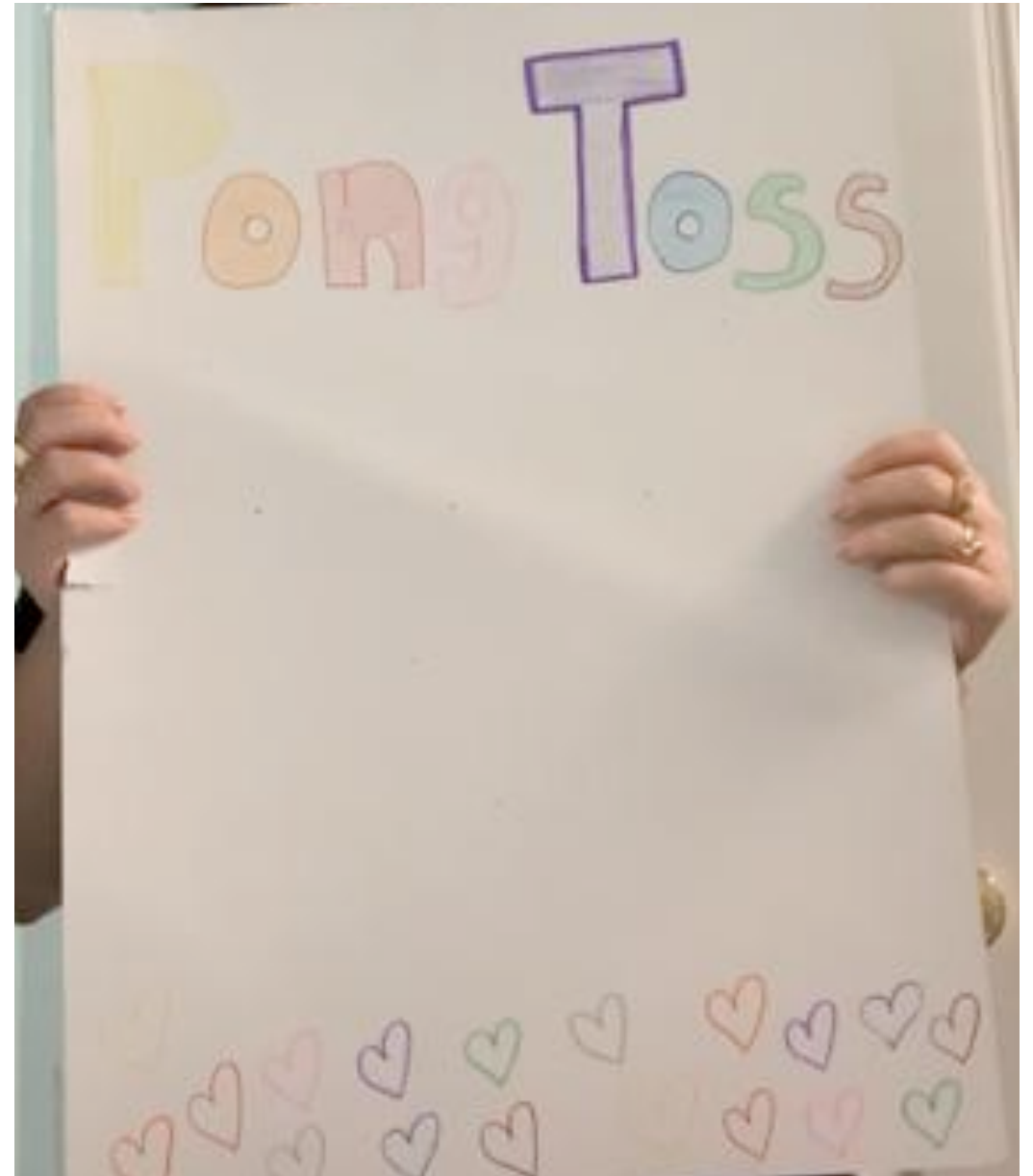


# Pong Toss Step 2:

Once your board has the markings of where your cups are going to be glued, you can begin to decorate it.

Write Pong Toss on the top so everyone knows what game it is.

Decorate the rest of the board on top and underneath where the marking are. You can make whatever designs, or you can write our a point system for scoring!



# Pong Toss Step 3:

Now glue on the cups. Preferably with hot glue, glue down the cups one at a time. Make sure to push the cups down from the inside of the cup so it really gets glued to the board.

Glue them down in a pyramid shape, with four cups in one line, then three cups, then two cups, and then one cup.

Let this dry until the cups don't all off the board when you pick the board up.



# Pong Toss Step 4:

Once the board is ready to be used, let's start playing!

Allow everyone to have a shot at throwing the ball at the cups and see if they can get the ball to land inside of the cup!

Depending on your point scoring system, see who gets the most points and wins!
