


MAGIC PAPER TOWELS



Tools

- ❖ Paper Towels
- ❖ Sharpies
- ❖ Washable Markers
- ❖ Bowl With Water



Step 1:

Rip off a piece of paper towel.

You can rip off as many pieces as you want, but keep in mind that each piece is going to be its own picture.

Fold the paper towel in half, so it looks like a square instead of a rectangle.



Step 2:

On the top of the paper towel square, draw a picture with sharpies. It should just be the outline of a picture.

If you're drawing a rainbow, just use the sharpies to draw the lines of the rainbow, but don't color it in.

You only want an outline on the top piece of the paper towel because that's what's going to hide your picture and make the magic happen.



Step 3:

Lift up the top piece you drew on. On the bottom inside piece of paper towel, you should see that the sharpie bled through and made an outline on that piece.

Color in the picture or add to the outline with more pictures.

Make sure to color this part with washable markers so the color will bleed through when it gets wet.




Step 4:

Get a bowl of water that is big enough for the paper towel to float inside.

Fold the paper towel back so it's a square, with just the outline picture showing on top, and the colored in picture hiding.

Put the paper towel in the bowl of water and watch how quickly it gets wet. As it does, the picture underneath will pop through, like magic!



OMG...it is magic!

How does it work? Is it magic?

When the water soaks through the paper towels, the colors from the bottom layer will begin to show through to the top layer, making it look like it appeared by magic!

If you're going to do different pictures, change the water in between each picture so the water is clear and not full of color.
