

MASON JAR PHOTO VASE

Tools

- Clear Mason Jar
- **❖**Acrylic Paint
- Paintbrushes
- ❖ Painter's Tape
- **❖**Family Photo









Step 1:

Set up your workspace. Make sure to cover wherever you're working so the paint doesn't get on it.

Using painters tape, cover up a piece of the mason jar, like a window, so it doesn't get painted.

You can cover it in any shape you want. This will show your picture once you're done painting the jar.



Step 2:

Paint the mason jar whatever color you want it to be. You may need to let it dry for 10-15 minutes after the first coat of paint and then go back and add more paint so it's darker.

While the paint is wet, you can shake on some matching colored or colorful glitter so your mason jar is glittery and fun when it's totally dried.



Step 3:

Once you are done painting, peel off the painters tape right away. If you leave it on, whatever paint got on it will dry and then you won't be able to remove the tape.

You should now see a window in whatever shape you put the tape on. That's where your picture is going to go.

Let the vase dry completely for 24 hours or overnight before putting in the picture.



Step 4:

Once the vase is totally dried, it's time to put in your picture. Print out a picture or take a printed picture of whatever you want!

Measure the picture to the window and then cut the picture to fit. Leave some extra room so you can glue it in.

Glue the extra sides of the picture and then put it inside of the vase, pushing it against the window so you can see it from. Let it dry completely.



Step 5:

A vase isn't complete without some flowers!

Make fake flowers out of tissue paper and put those inside so you can give your mom her own bouquet of flowers for Mother's Day.
