2 Toilet Paper Rolls

Hot Glue Gun

Step 1:

Take your two toilet paper rolls and paint them. They can both be the same color, different colors, or full of color.

If you don't want to paint, you can also cover them completely in different colors of washi tape or glue on construction paper.

Use the clothes pins to help stand the rolls up for easier drying without any mess.



Step 2:

Once the paint (or glue) is totally done drying, let's glue on our ribbon. You can staple on the ribbon too, but it will make a bump when you cover it.

Cut one long piece of ribbon, long enough to go around your neck and let the binoculars hang down.

Glue each end of the ribbon to one side of rolls and let it dry.



Step 3:

Let's glue the rolls together to make the binoculars.

Making sure the two ribbons are on opposite ends so they form a loop, glue the rolls together.

The clothes pin will help hold the rolls together while they are drying. You can also hot glue them for faster drying.



Step 4:

Using washi tape or other decorating materials, cover the area where you glued down the ribbon so it's not noticeable.

You want to hide the ribbon under something fun and pretty.

Allow the decoration and the ribbon to dry completely until you can lift up the binoculars.



Step 5:

Once the binoculars are glued together and totally dry, finish up decorating them.

Decorate them with tons of fun stuff so they are ready for an adventure.

Something fun and different: the ribbon you use for the necklace part of the binoculars could be filled with beads before you glue it on so your necklace is colorful also!
