

Puffy Paint

Ingredients & Tools



- ❖ White Glue
- ❖ Foaming Shaving Cream
- ❖ Canvas or Cardstock Paper
- ❖ Paintbrushes
- ❖ Large Plastic Bowl
- ❖ Plastic Spoons
- ❖ Plastic Bowls
- ❖ Food Coloring
- ❖ Measuring Cups - 1 cup



Step 1:

Pour a generous amount of glue into a large bowl, about 1 cup.

Mix in an equally generous amount of foaming shaving cream to the bowl, also about 1 cup. Make sure to add the shaving cream immediately from the bottle so it's fluffy and foamy.



Step 2:

Add about 10–15 drops of food coloring to the mixture.

Mix everything together gently until everything is the color you picked.

The paint will be puffy and fluffy and ready for fun.



Step 3:

Paint away!

You'll have to add a lot of puffy paint to get the puffy texture on the paper, but it is so cool to see how it pops off of your paper!

When you're done painting, let it dry. Touch it once it's dry and see how it's still foamy!



Some Notes...

Repeat the recipe as many times as you'd like so you can get a bunch of different colors to paint with!

You can cut down the amount by not using 1 cup of shaving cream and glue each. You can do $\frac{1}{2}$ cup shaving cream and glue each. It just has to be equal parts of shaving cream and glue!

If you don't have foaming shaving cream, but you have gel shaving cream, this will still work! Squeeze the amount of gel shaving cream you are using into an empty bowl. With a spoon, mix it until it becomes super foamy. Now you can add it into your glue and mix away with food coloring!
