



**SHARPIE DOODLES
ON FOIL**

Ingredients

❖ Aluminum Foil

❖ Cardboard Box

❖ Washi Tape

❖ Black Sharpie

❖ Colorful Sharpies

❖ Glitter Tubes/Puffy Paint (Optional)



Step 1:

Take a smooth piece of a cardboard box. You can cut a regular box to make a square if you need to.

Take a piece of silver foil and carefully flatten it over the cardboard box. Be careful not to rip it!

Tape the silver foil down using washi tape and use your fingers to gently smooth any bumps or wrinkles.



Step 2:

Using a black Sharpie, gently doodle on your page.

You can draw an actual picture or make a doodlefest:

A doodlefest is when you draw a loopy line all around the paper, swirling it and overlapping more lines around it.

Do it gently so the Sharpie doesn't make a hole!

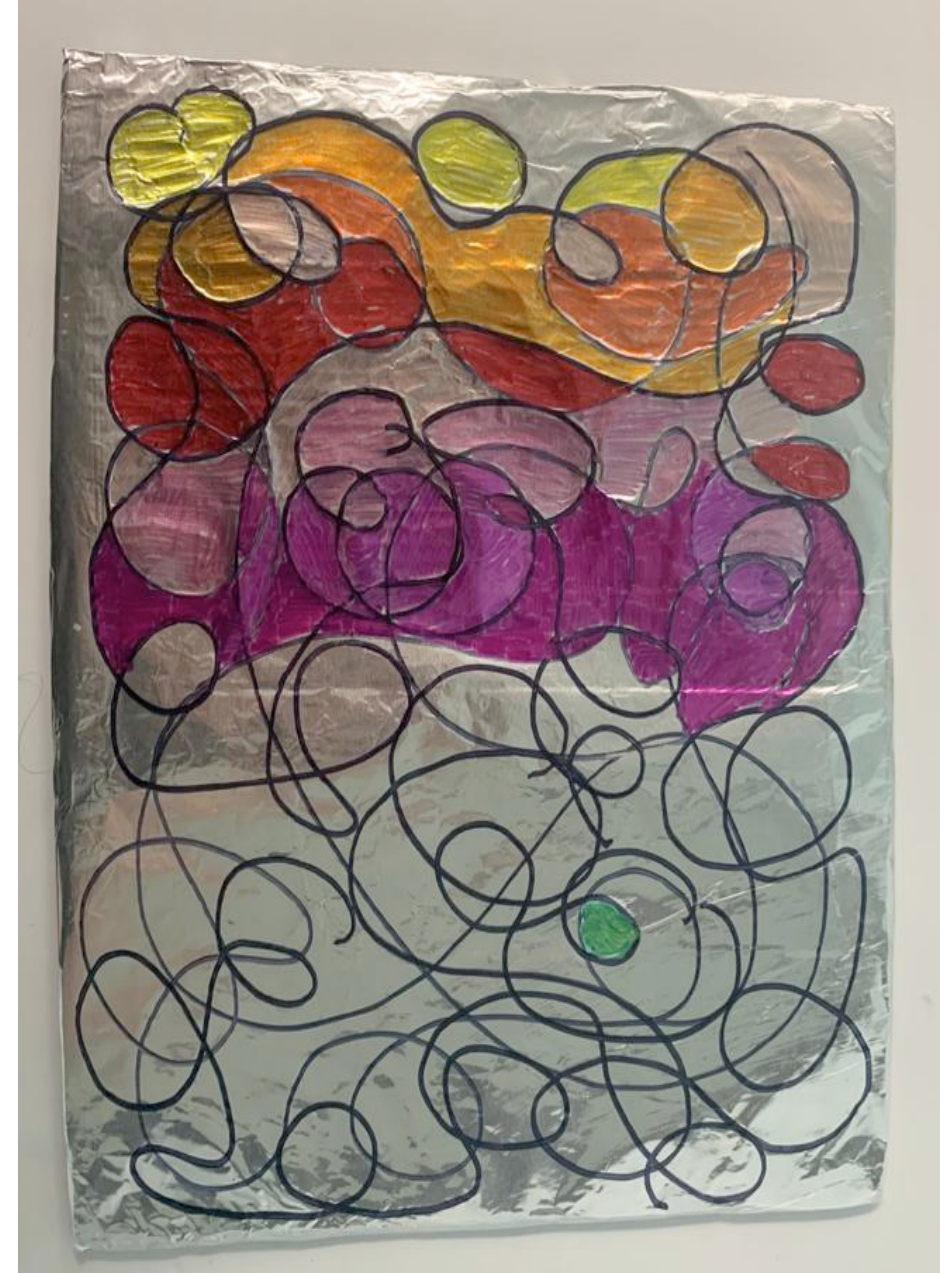


Step 3:

Let the black Sharpie dry so it doesn't get onto your hands.

Use colorful Sharpies to color in all of the pictures and doodling you drew on your foil paper.

When you're done coloring, if you want to add puffy paint or glitter glue to your picture you can. It will give it a cool 3D effect.
