MACCABI GAMES: AN OVERVIEW

The JCC Maccabi Games are hosted each summer by several communities throughout North America as a week-long Olympic-style sports competition. Since 1982, the summer Games have brought together more than 180,000 teen athletes to compete during the one-week summer event.

Each year, teens ages 13-16 from more than 100 JCCs and communities from around the world gather to compete, explore their identities, develop lasting friendships, and work together to make a real difference in the Jewish world.

The Maccabi Games are remembered fondly by many as "the best week of summer."

The program includes, but is not limited to:

- An unforgettable Olympic-style opening ceremony
- · Exciting social events throughout the day and into the evenings
- Thrilling sporting events
- Catered meals and full transportation
- A hospitable Jewish host family experience
- A JCC Cares chesed program
- Second Sports: the opportunity for athletes to compete in alternative sports if eliminated from the competition

LOGISTICS AND PAYMENT INFO

As we approach the Games, more detailed information will be provided regarding: travel, housing, sport-specific matchups, and more. Until then, here's what to look forward to:

- Host an informational Zoom meeting. Perfect for athlete and parent Q&As. TBA.

- Provide a payment schedule to you. Detailing what's due and when.

- · Share specific rules with athletes, so they can perform at their best.
- Assist the kids with fundraising. To help subsidize the trip.

REGISTERING YOUR ATHLETE

The JCC Maccabi Games use the websites RegPack and CampDoc to gather athlete information, including: some medical information, participant agreement, waivers and releases, housing requests, parent information, and a photo upload for security credentials.
