

KIDS' POOL RULES

To ensure the most enjoyable pool experience possible, the Center strongly enforces the following rules:

CO-ED SWIM

- CHILDREN AGES 1 to 2 attending Co-Ed can change in the locker room of the opposite sex.
- CHILDREN AGES 3 TO 7 attending Co-Ed swimming must change in the instructor's room adjacent.

CHILDREN SWIMMING ON THEIR OWN

• **CHILDREN AGES 8 AND YOUNGER** must swim in the company of an adult at all times. See the schedule for available swim times. Ages will be verified.

However,

CHILDREN AGES 9 AND OLDER are permitted to swim unattended during select times:

GIRLS (9 and older)

BOYS (9 and older)

MON and WED, 6:00 to 9:00 PM

TUES and THURS, 6:00 to 9:00 PM

SCC Rule: "All children under the age of 10 unattended by an adult cannot be in the building after 9:00 PM."

MEMBERS 16 AND OLDER

- **ADULT SWIM** is reserved for those ages 16+ (and for those looking to swim laps, only) barring holiday exceptions. For details and holiday exceptions, check the aquatics bulletin board, or call the Aquatics Director at (718) 627-4300, ext. 3228.
- **USE OF THE SAUNA BY CHILDREN YOUNGER THAN 16** is prohibited at all times. You may anonymously report those in violation to our Aquatics staff.



So that you can swim safely and comfortably, the Center makes available these convenient facilities:

• TEMPORARY LOCKER USE

Lockers are available for the <u>daily</u> use of members, and are located in the first floor locker rooms.

We strongly recommend that you bring a padlock or combination lock on the day of your visit to help keep your belongings secure, however locks must be removed before you exit the building.

All unauthorized locks will be cut without question.

• LOCKER RENTALS

A limited number of lockers are available for rent on an annual basis. To secure your locker rental, contact the Aquatics Director, Yuriy Koyfman, at (718) 954-3228.

Rental Rates: SMALL LOCKERS / \$100 annually (pro-rated, if available)

LARGE LOCKERS / \$175 annually (pro-rated, if available)

• LOCKER ROOM USE

Our locker rooms are available for use all day, but entrance to the pool is forbidden 10 minutes before a swim session ends.

KNOW THE RULES AND SCHEDULE

We ask that kids and adults familiarize themselves with our pool rules and daily schedule. Ignorance is not an excuse. You may find both of these important documents at the first floor Reception Desk, or online at *SCCLive.org*.

• WE TAKE HYGIENE SERIOUSLY

Showers New York City's health code requires all swimmers to

rinse off before using the pool. Failure to do so

jeopardizes one's opportunity to swim.

Swimming Caps The Center's policy requires swimmers of all ages to

wear a swimming cap. Swimmers who don't have a

swimming cap available are expected to purchase one.

SCHEDULE

To ensure the most enjoyable pool experience possible, the Center provides time in the pool for members of all ages:

• WE FOLLOW OUR POOL SCHEDULE CLOSELY at the Center, so that all may have an equal chance to enjoy the pool. A copy of the latest schedule is provided on our website, at the front desk, and adjacent to this sign.

Be advised, however, that the pool schedule is subject to change (i.e. holidays, facility closures, rentals.)

So, before you disrobe and dive in, we ask that you familiarize yourself with our pool rules and schedule.

- **KEEP AN EYE ON THE CLOCK.** To assist in our commitment to maintain the highest quality aquatics programs, we're vigilant about our programs starting and ending on time. We urge you to enter and exit the facility on time.
- **FROM SEPTEMBER THROUGH JUNE,** on Mondays and Tuesdays from 1:00 to 2:00 PM, the locker rooms are used by our Early Childhood Program.
- ALSO, ON WEDNESDAYS FROM 1:30 TO 3:00 PM FROM SEPT. THOURGH JUNE, the locker rooms are used by Imagine Academy (including boys, girls, and female instructors).
