

#### **Tools**

- Canvas or Cardstock Paper
- Glue (Tacky Glue Preferred)
- ❖ Buttons (Single Color)\*
- ❖ Decorating Gems (Single Color) (Optional)\*
- Paintbrushes
- Printed Silhouette Picture of Disney Princess

\* If you don't have buttons, use decorating gems. Choose colors based on the color of your princess dress.












### Step 1:

Pick out the Disney princess you want to decorate. Google a picture of the character you want and print out a silhouette picture of the character.

(I googled Cinderella Silhouette Dress and printed the picture I liked).

Glue the picture to the canvas board and let it dry while you sort out the buttons you're going to use.



## Step 2:

Using a paintbrush, put some glue on 1/3 of the dress.

Start to press buttons onto the glue and make sure to use different sizes and shades to make the dress unique.

Use smaller buttons to decorate the edges of the dress.



### Step 3:

Finish putting glue on the rest of the dress and keep adding buttons until the entire dress is filled up.


If your princess has a headband or tiara (crown), then put some glue and buttons there also.



#### Step 4:

Lay the canvas down and let the buttons dry until they are firmly glued to the picture.

With all of the empty white space, write a quote from your princess or draw a picture for your princess as their background.
