

Ingredients & Tools

- **❖**White Table Salt
- **❖**White Glue
- Liquid Watercolors
- Canvas or Cardstock Paper
- Paintbrushes or Droppers
- ❖ Disposable Gloves
- Plastic bowls





Step 1:

Decide what you want to draw on your canvas. Using a pencil, draw your picture.

Set up your workspace now. Wherever you're doing it, set up a plastic tablecloth or towel.

Set up the plastic bowls with the liquid watercolors for easy dipping.






Step 2:

Take a bottle of glue and outline your picture with glue.

If you want, you can fill in all the empty spaces in your picture with glue also.

Remember: wherever you put glue is where the salt is going to stick!





Step 3:

Pour the salt all over the glue. Make sure to cover the entire canvas in an even layer of salt.

Once everything is covered, shake off the salt very gently. You'll see it stuck to all the glue and the rest fell off the paper!






Step 4:

Using your paintbrushes or liquid droppers, gently paint the salt with the liquid watercolor paint. You'll see the paint spread a little over the salt.

Keep painting until all of your salt is colored and your picture is fully painted.

Let it dry flat before moving it so the salt can harden and the paint dries.
